**JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM**

The Muni’s golf staff would like to welcome everyone for an exciting educational golf experience. Our goal is to provide a fun, safe atmosphere conducive to learning this great game. Throughout the program we will emphasize rules, etiquette and the fundamentals of all aspects pertaining to golf. We encourage parental/ legal guardian participation during clinics. The Junior Golf Program will be every Thursday for six weeks for students ages 8-17 and three weeks for ages 5-7. To provide a top-level golf clinic and continue COVID safety protocols we have limited the number of participants to 20. Sign up will be first come first serve. The following is the schedule for the 2021 Junior Golf Program.

## JUNIOR GOLF RULES

### DRESS CODE

Clothing must be worn in a neat and respectable manner at all times.

Proper attire for Junior Golf includes:

- Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Shirts are required.
- Non-metal spike shoes or athletic shoes must be worn at all times.

Improper attire includes, but is not limited to:

- Cut-offs, bathing suits.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

*Juniors participating in the Junior Golf Program are expected to practice honesty and uphold the integrity of the game of golf. Juniors are the future of golf and will behave within the following guidelines at all times. Although we will not be conducting play days on the golf course we will still be hosting hitting, chipping and putting games throughout clinic sessions in which the following rules apply.*

- The USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play.
- A (2) stroke penalty may be assessed every time a participant leaves trash or fails to pick up trash at Casper Municipal Golf Course.
- A (2) stroke penalty may be assessed every time a participant fails to replace a divot or repair a ball mark.
- Obvious and subsequent violations will result in disqualification.
- Any conduct that is detrimental to the Junior Golf Program will not be tolerated.



Behavior that will result in a **WARNING**:

- Improper attire (see Dress Code)
- Lack of respect for others

Behavior that will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**:

- Cheating
- Lack of respect for volunteers or officials
- Damage to course or property
- Throwing clubs
- Obscene, abusive, or vulgar language

### **ETIQUETTE REMINDERS**

- Replace all divots
- Be quiet and still when a player is hitting or putting
- Throwing clubs is NOT allowed, ever!
- Protect the greens
  - Pick up your feet when you walk
  - Place golf bags off the green
  - Repair your ball marks
  - No running on the greens
- Always walk around the line of other players
- All putts must be holed out
- Be sure players are out of range before taking your shot
- Count all your strokes
- The player who is furthest away hits first - Be Ready!
- Be a good sport at all times

## **PARENT/ PLAYER GUARDIANS**

We encourage all parents and legal guardians to participate. However, if you are unable to participate we ask you as the parent or guardian to make sure the participant is here 10 minutes prior and that you are here a minimum of 10 minutes before the session ends to pick up the participant. If you are going to be late, please call the golf shop. Failure to pick up a student within 15 minutes of class ending may result in disqualification from clinics.
